MEDICATIONS TO DISCONTINUE PRIOR TO SURGERY

Please stop/discontinue taking any of the following medications 7 days prior to surgery:

- Anti-Platelet Agents (Plavix)
- Over-the-Counter Medications
- Herbal Remedies
- Nutritional Supplements
- Ibuprofen
- Motrin
- Advil
- Bufferin
- Excedrin
- Aleve
- Ecotrin
- Anacin
- Pletal
- Alka-Seltzer
- Arthritis Formulas
- Vitamin E
- Garlic Capsules
- Ginko Biloba
- Multivitamin Formulas

Please stop/discontinue taking any of the following medications prior to surgery:

- Coumadin (Warfarin) <u>4 days</u>
- Lovenox <u>as directed by your</u> <u>physician</u>
- Heparin <u>as directed by your</u> physician

Please discontinue any birth control pills **1 month** before scheduled procedure (unless otherwise specified by your specialist).

If you take high blood pressure, heart, diabetic, or any other medications consult with your **physician that prescribed** these medications whether or not you may take it the morning of your procedure.

Remember to drink plenty of **liquids** the day before your procedure.
